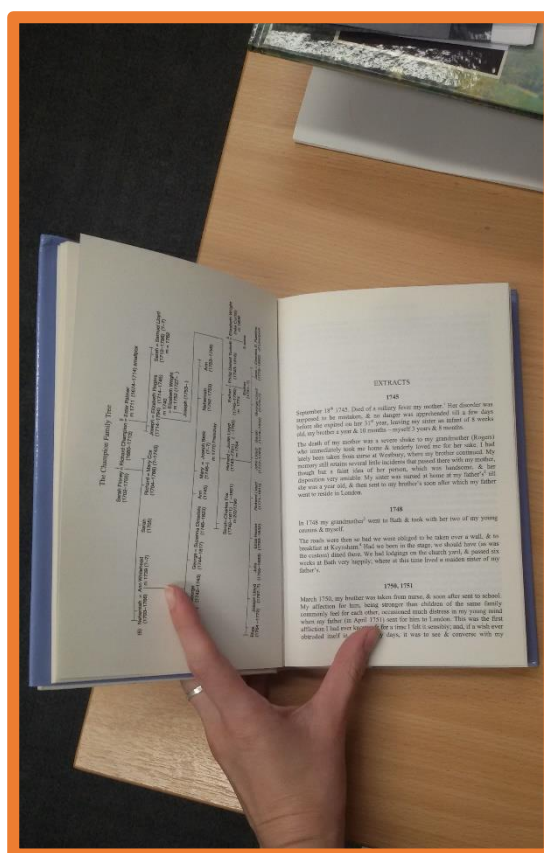
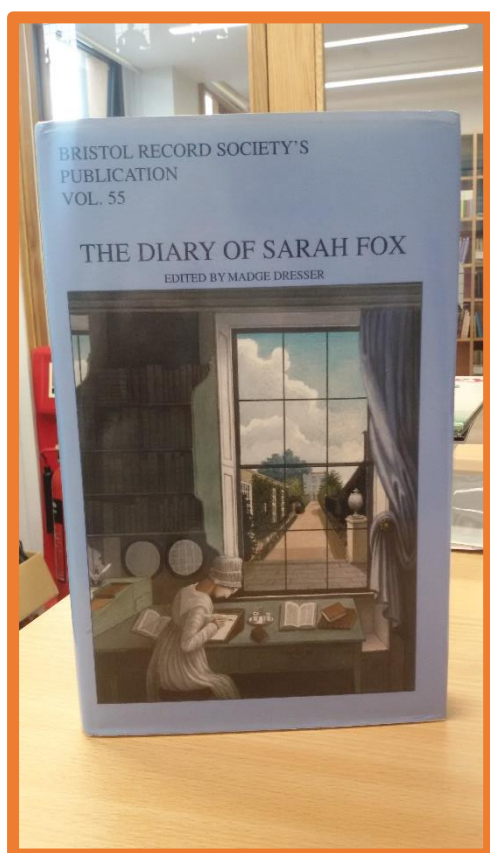


The New Room Library 'Our Favourites' Book of the Month
